What We Need From You

If you would like to nominate yourself or a colleague, please submit:

1. High-Resolution Half Body Portrait

- Colour
- Professional quality
- Minimum 300 dpi
- Portrait orientation
- Signed image license and consent form

2. Written Profile (Maximum 200 Words - likely to use > 50)

A concise paragraph outlining:

- What the individual has delivered
- How their work has helped advance the nuclear industry
- The tangible or lasting impact of their contribution
- Why their commitment exemplifies an “everyday hero”

This should focus on outcomes and impact — not a full CV.

3. Basic Details

- Name
- Current role and organisation
- Years in the nuclear sector (approximate is fine)
- Country of work
- LinkedIn profile (optional)

Reference photographs

The photography language for this campaign is “everyday capture of a person in their workplace.” An iphone in portrait mode works really well. Don’t worry too much about the background as we’ll remove this for the creative treatment. The most important thing is to have a waist-up shot.
